
Rispoli Giacomo**Director of Research and Technological Development in the Eni S.p.A. Society R&M Division in Rome**

Giacomo Rispoli, born in 1957, graduated in Chemistry Engineering in Rome. He was hired in the group in 1986 and in 1990, was nominated Responsible of the Technological Service and Control of the refinery of Taranto where one of his main activities was the improvement of the thermoelectric plant.

Three years later he was nominated Manager, Responsible of AgipPetroli Structural Projects with the aim of spotting the structural modifications to give to the industrial system to adapt to the oil scenario change.

From 1994 he was responsible of the Oil-refining Management Control and from 1996 of the Industrial Management to ensure the right employment of the seven refineries, using benchmarking techniques with the aim to evaluate the competitive position of the AgipPetroli industrial system, he was also in charge of other important activities within the finished products quality area.

In 1997 he becomes responsible of the working operative program accomplishment and since 1999 he is Responsible of the AgipPetroli Supply. He managed the refineries of Venice, Taranto and Gela and since the year 2000 he is responsible of the Industrial Management. In this position he improved the reaction capacity of the Industrial System in the context of the variation of the international oil scenario.

Giacomo Rispoli gave a concrete contribution in studying problems of the international refineries. He worked on the negotiation of important contracts with Enel, obtaining a significant economic result the electric energy production increase at the same time synergy with oil business.

For four years from 2001 he has been director of the refinery of Venice of the AgipPetroli/Eni S.p.A. society. He promoted a series of initiatives, as working groups and contacts with the University of Venice, to make the refinery more aware of security and environmental themes which are prerequisite for carrying out the activity.

At last, from 2004 he has been President and Director of the Refinery of Gela S.p.A., set up a strategy to normalize relations with institutions and in December 2004 was able to envision a plan for the project of a new plant. All these enactments gave excellent results on establishing performance and relations with the territory.

Today, Dr. Rispoli is Director of Research and Technological Development since May 2006 in the R&M Division Eni S.p.A. Society in Rome. He manages the research activities and technological development of the R&M Division and promotes competitive innovative technology appliances, developed inside the group or acquired from the market. Besides he is responsible of the

observance of the legislation and conservancy of the environment and public safety.
